Despite the economic pressures which are being felt across primary education in the uk as a whole, The dedication and excellence of the staff at Austhorpe is to be commended.	Positive comments about the visit Having spoken with the children about how they feel when in school, safe, happy, sad, frightened.. All said they were happy and knew to tell an adult if they were upset by someone or hurt. All the staff I spoke to knew who the DSL's were and the process for disclosure. The whole safe guarding process was deeply embedded amongst the staff. All safe guarding information was displayed prominently in the staff room notice board. The new school values board looked amazing in the reception area. As usual there was a happy and warm atmosphere throughout the school.
